ACO "Ask an Expert" Heritage Trade Fair, to be held March 17th, 2007

Port Hope, Ontario – February 23, 2007: The Port Hope Branch of the Architectural Conservancy of Ontario will be holding the first in its series of Saturday morning “Heritage Trade Fair” information sessions in the Program Room at the Port Hope Library on Saturday March 17th from 10 a.m. until 12 noon.

Each event will feature up to three heritage trade exhibitors who will display examples of their craft. Attendees will be able to ask the exhibitors questions and get suggestions and advice on their own projects.

This first event will feature Peter and Jane Rungay who have graciously agreed to describe their restoration projects, answer questions and provide advice, where appropriate. They will have photos of their recent projects and talk to anyone interested in finding and restoring old houses.

Also featured will be Tony Trevor who is a refinisher of fine furniture and wooden architectural details such as staircases and mantelpieces. Tony will be there to answer questions not only about the art of restoring the finish on your furniture but what it takes to refurbish your stair railings and banisters as well. He could also be consulted on how to care for your newly restored or refinished artifacts.

Admission to the event is free.

The second session in the series will be held at the Living Green Fair, May 5th, at the Port Hope Town Park in the Fall Fair Centre building.
